

The Goal of Unity with the Holy Spirit

Overview: We have often prayed, “More of God in me and less of me, until there is all of God and none of me.” This is the goal of unity with the Holy Spirit. As we achieve this unity, we manifest more and more His promises in our lives.

A. The Promises in the Present

1. Power in our prayers

Joh 15:7 If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.

Rom 8:14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.

Psa 91:10 No evil shall befall you.

Luke 10:19 Nothing of the enemy shall by any means harm you.

2. Unity

Joh 17:21 That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me.

Joh 17:22 And the glory which thou gavest me I have given them; that they may be one, even as we are one:

Eph 5:25,6 Becoming part of the **Glorious Church** by being washed by the Water of the Word.

Col 2:9 For in him dwelleth all the fullness of the Godhead bodily.

Col 2:10 And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power:

3. Perfection in Him

Joh 17:23 I in them, and thou in me, that they may be made perfect in one; and that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me.

Joh 14:21 He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him.

1Jn 4:17 Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgment: because as he is, so are we in this world.

B. The Promises in the Ending Days

1. Intimacy with Jesus for those on fire for God

Rev 3:15 I know thy works, that thou art neither cold nor hot: I would thou wert cold or hot.

Rev 3:16 So then because thou art lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spue thee out of my mouth.

Rev 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me.

2. Supernatural Protection

Acts 16:31 **Building your ark** for yourself and family

Rev 11:5 And if any man will hurt them, fire proceedeth out of their mouth, and devoureth their enemies: and if any man will hurt them, he must in this manner be killed.

3. Supernatural Warfare

Rev 13:7 And it was given unto him to make war with the saints, and to overcome them: and power was given him over all kindreds, and tongues, and nations.

Rev 13:8 And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.

Rev 13:9 If any man have an ear, let him hear.

Rev 13:10 He that leadeth into captivity shall go into captivity: he that killeth with the sword must be killed with the sword. Here is the patience and the faith of the saints.

C. The Promises in the Millennial Kingdom

1. The Blessings of Overcoming

Rev 3:21 To him that overcometh will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with my Father in his throne.

Rev 2:26 And he that overcometh, and keepeth my works unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations:

Rev 2:27 And he shall rule them with a rod of iron; as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers: even as I received of my Father.

2. Freedom from the Second Death

Rev 2:7 To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God

Rev 2:10 Be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life.

. Rev 20:4 And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years.

Rev 20:5 But the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished. This is the first resurrection.

Rev 20:6 Blessed and holy is he that hath part in the first resurrection: **on such the second death hath no power**, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years.

3. Heaven on Earth

Rev 21:4 And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.

Power Prayer

The recommendation is to pray this after you have confessed your known sins and invited the Holy Spirit to fall afresh on you.

“Heavenly Father, in the Name of Jesus, I thank you that the Spirit of the Lord is upon me: the Spirit of Power and Might, the Spirit of Wisdom and Understanding, the Spirit of Counsel and Might, the Spirit of Knowledge and of the Fear of the Lord, giving me quick understanding of the Fear of the Lord (Isa 11:2) and of all circumstances of life; and bringing back to my short, medium, and long-term memory, everything that I need for life and godliness for I have the mind of Christ.

In the Name of Jesus, God is my strength, my personal bravery and my invincible army (Hab 3:19 AMPC), so that I can do all things through Christ Jesus, who strengthens me (Phil 4:13) for I am a super-conqueror in Christ Jesus (Rom 8:37).

In the Name of Jesus, every cell organ and system in my body has been perfected by Jesus Christ (Heb 10:14) so I declare that every cell, organ and system in my body has (*or they have*) been healed, restored and rejuvenated by the stripes of Jesus.

I have been perfected by Jesus. I am complete in Christ Jesus. I have been predestinated, called, justified and glorified by Jesus (Rom 8:30), therefore I am part of the Glorious Church without spot or wrinkle.

I am justified by my words (Matt 12:37) and my words are that the same Spirit who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in me (Rom 8:11) and pumps life into my mortal flesh so that I will be alive and remain and be raptured at the coming of the Son of Man as King of Kings, Amen.”
